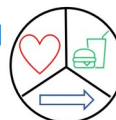

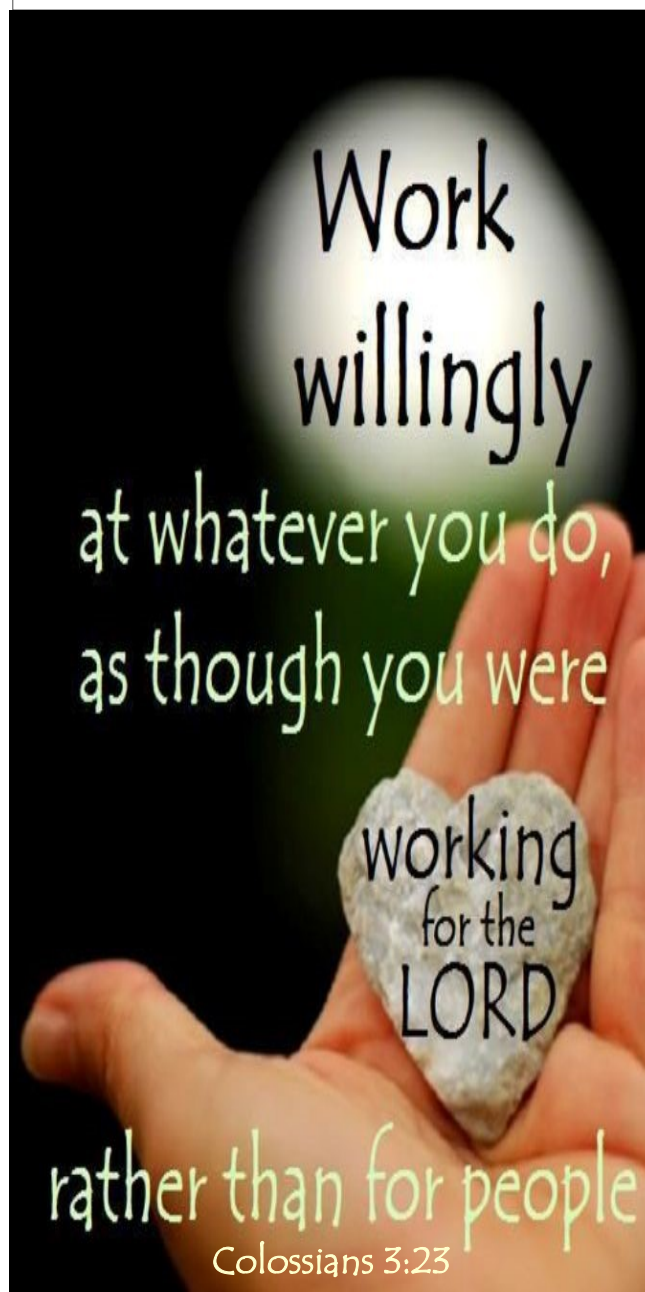

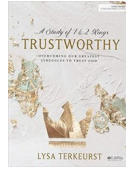
DEACON RECOMMENDATIONS
