

We are in the final days of our churchwide 40 Day Prayer
Challenge, and I am excited about the benefits that our

homes, our workplaces, our community, and our church will reap as a result of this season of intentional prayer. Whether you have been part of one of our small groups or not, I want to encourage you to remain steadfast in prayer in 2025. The prayer challenge has provided an opportunity to focus on some of the "howto's" of our prayer life, but let us remember that one of the great spiritual dangers we face is learning how but forgetting why. Like anything else in life, our prayers can become mindless expressions if we forget why they are so vital.

The psalmist implores us in Psalm 96:1 to sing a new song to the Lord. "In the same way, we need to sing a new song, we need to pray a new prayer. It's easy to fall into a prayer rut and repeat all the prayer cliches we know followed by "Amen". If we aren't careful, we pray without thinking — and that is just as destructive as thinking without praying." (Mark Batterson) Continue to pray fervently, intentionally, specifically, and brokenly! I'm hearing great testimonies about how these 40 days of prayer are encouraging and challenging those who are participating, and I know God is using this season to prepare FBC Meridian for big kingdom plans in the days ahead!
