



## In Jesus' day, your outer coat was your most important piece of clothing.

Coats were even exempt from seizure by the court under Jewish law (m. B. Qam 8:6) around this time.

They didn't cast their coats down because they were unimportant; they did so to highlight that Jesus was more important.



## Notice that Jesus is doubly elevated on the coats of the crowd and his disciples.

## Jesus knew even better than the crowds that some things are more precious than coats.

## What they laid down for Jesus did not compare to what Jesus would lay down for them—and for us.
