

VBS 2021 is headed to present-day Israel where discovery awaits at **Destination Dig.** Kids will unearth more than dirt as they dig up exciting evidence that proves biblical events were not just stories. As junior archaeologists, they will explore real-life archaeological finds that have helped to uncover the truth about Jesus! Along the way, they'll discover the truth of Jeremiah 29:13, that God reveals Himself to us when we seek and search for Him with all our hearts.



On Mother's Day, May 9, First Baptist Church will gather our annual Mother's Day Offering to benefit The Baptist Children's Village. (There will be an offering envelope in your Order of Worship.)

Since 1897, The Baptist Children's Village has relied totally on gifts from God's people to sustain this ministry, which now includes both residential and non-residential programs and serves over 200 children each year.

The residential program is designed to meet the long-term needs of children, ages 1 through 20. Children in this program remain until they may be reunited with their families or otherwise placed in caring family environments. Some residents remain until they are equipped to function independently. During their stay, each child lives in a cottage on one of seven campuses with other residents and Christian adults (houseparents). The children will share a bedroom with one or two others, each one having their own bed and closet space. They will attend local public schools and Baptist churches in the community, and participate in many recreational activities, both on and off campus.

The non-residential program, the Dorcas In-Home Family Support Program, is designed to aid families in creating homes that are safe and stable for children, providing education and training in areas such as child-rearing and appropriate discipline, household budgeting and shopping, meal planning and preparation, and household safety and care. They also assist families in obtaining community services such as healthcare, education, and childcare. This minimizes the likelihood of these children being taken into state custody.

Please pray for The Baptist Children's Village and give generously to support this ministry.


