NEEDS: A devastating tornado hit Rolling Fork, MS on March 23, 2023. The hospital, school, post office, and other businesses were destroyed along with 325 homes.

RESPONSE TO NEEDS: FBC Rolling Fork through *Rolling Fork Rising* has the vision of allowing former residents to return as homeowners. The very survival of their town and their church hangs in the balance. They are attempting to restore their community by building homes that can be sold to those with no place to live.

WHAT CAN WE DO?: Our church is committing to volunteer labor in the building of these homes. (*Skill Sets Needed: frame and finish carpentry, dry wall hanging and floating, cooking, helpers and house keeping, painting, roofing, etc.*) Actually, almost any skill can be used. 
