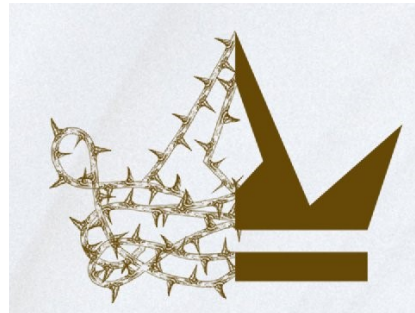

PRIORITIES

“She had a sister named Mary, who sat at the Lord’s feet and listened to what He was saying.”
(Luke 10:39)

A young man was applying for a job. As a part of the increasingly more-complicated application process, he had to take a series of psychological and aptitude tests. As the test began, the young man’s attention focused on surrounding things such as the sharpened pencils and their number-two lead. He checked out the special erasers and straightened the papers countless times. Then suddenly, to his surprise, the testing time was over. The poor guy had been so engrossed in the inconsequential that he never took the test!

Today’s verse is taken from the experience of Jesus with Mary and Martha. Martha was busy doing all kinds of housekeeping things, which in most cases, would have been very appropriate. Yet, Jesus made it very clear that on this occasion Mary was the one who was addressing the real needs of the moment, both hers and those of Jesus. She had her priorities in the right order. Priorities are not a once-in-a-lifetime choice. They must be reviewed regularly, even daily. Are we focusing our attention on that which really matters, or are we being sidetracked by what appeals to us at the moment?
