WHO'S IN CHARGE HERE?

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

Matthew 28:19

An army colonel walked in to a command post and said, "I'd like to talk to someone here with a little authority." The corporal at the desk answered, "Well, sir, you can talk to me. I have about as little authority around here as anyone."

The question of authority is one with which we always have to deal. Who has authority in our home? At our workplace? In our government? In our personal lives? The question of authority frames our entire lives. Who makes the decisions? Who exercises control? Who has the final say in our lives?

Jesus said that he was granted full authority by his heavenly father to send the disciples out with instructions as to how they were to live their lives. Another step was involved, however, and it is somewhat ironic. The authority given to Jesus by God can only be exercised in our lives when we grant him that authority. He never forces it upon us. With all the authority heaven can give him, our Lord becomes the influence in our lives only when we allow. Who is the authority in your life? "Lord, help me to be honest about who is calling the shots in my life. Help me to grant you the same authority as does the Father in heaven."
